# **Advanced Pharmacotherapeutics**

## **Online Continuing Education for Advanced Practice Nurses**

### **WVU School of Nursing**

#### **Course Overview**

This online course is designed to review, expand, and update the practitioner's knowledge of pharmacology and pharmacotherapeutics. The approach is to teach at the conceptual level by incorporating overviews of underlying disease processes and reviews of pharmacological principles into discussions of available therapeutic agents and the rationale for their use. Typical didactic lectures are pre-recorded and archived in segments via webcast technology. This 12-module program has been approved by West Virginia University School of Nursing, Charleston Division for a total 60 contact hours for the entire course or 3.5 - 7 contact hour individual modules. WVUSON – Charleston Division is an approved provider of continuing education for Registered Professional Nurses by the West Virginia Board of Examiners for Registered Professional Nurses. ## **Course Objectives**

Upon completion of any module of this course, the student will be able to:

- 1. Describe the pathophysiology of certain disease states and the rationale for the use of selected pharmacotherapy interventions.
- 2. Explain the pharmacology (mechanism of action, effects, pharmacokinetics, side effects, etc.) of the drugs discussed for each disease.
- 3. Discuss drugs of choice and alternatives for a given patient and disease.
- 4. Anticipate potential side effects, recognize adverse reactions, and discuss their management.
- 5. Communicate the appropriate patient education information regarding drug therapy for a given disease.

### **Course Requirements**

This course may be taken as a continuing education course in its entirety or in 4.5-hour modules. Each module meets the pharmacology continuing education requirements for limited prescriptive authority as specified by the West Virginia Board of Registered Professional Nurses. To qualify for continuing education credits you must follow the following steps:
