

RN to BSN Program – Full Time Progression Plan

Our online RN to BSN program offers licensed registered nurses who are graduates of diploma and associate degree nursing programs the opportunity to complete requirements for the Bachelor of Science in Nursing degree (BSN).

The RN to BSN program is designed for completion in as little as two to three semesters of study option, depending upon general education requirements completed. All nursing courses are offered as web courses, and 30 credits of RN to BSN nursing courses are required to complete the program. The following progression plan options reflect nursing requirements only. Please see a nursing advisor regarding how to incorporate other degree requirements in the plan of study.
