

RN to BSN PROGRESSION PLANS

The RN to BSN program is an online, asynchronous program which offers licensed registered nurses who have earned a diploma or associate degree in nursing the opportunity to complete requirements for the Bachelor of Science in Nursing degree (BSN).

The RN to BSN program is designed for completion in as few as two to three semesters of study option, depending upon general education requirements completed. All Nursing courses are offered every semester as web-based courses, and 30 credits of RN to BSN Nursing courses are required for program completion.

The following full and part-time progression plans reflect Nursing courses requirement only. An assigned academic advisor will assist students with incorporation of other degree requirements in the plan of study.
